

November 17, 2021

A board meeting of the Pacific Northwest Quarter Horse Association was called to order on November 17, 2021, by President Randi McCallum at 6:45 pm. Members also in attendance, via video, were Wade Kirksey, Shawn Charters, Bri Charters, Charlene Cooper, LeAnne Coldwell-Givens, and Patty Brown.

The purpose of the meeting was to make decisions regarding the annual awards banquet, and the choice of awards yet to be ordered. LeAnne brought a sample of the steel drink tumblers that she has provided. She has purchased 250 of them. She has also purchased 250 zippered pouches that can be used by club members to protect their important documents, such as show paperwork. Wade Kirksey has conducted an inventory of awards the club currently has, and is taking a few of them to a local company to have the PNQHA logo attached.

The PNQHA currently has enough awards in inventory to cover the 8 Reserve Champion awards for 2021. The board decided to also purchase 10 hi-point award buckles from Molly's buckles, including 5 for ranch and 5 for the open class year-end awards. Shawn is forwarding our order as soon as possible to Molly's buckle company.

The location of the annual awards meeting has thus far not been determined. Randi will continue to try to contact Indian Creek Restaurant. The board decided on January 21, 2022 for the date, if a venue is available. The dinner meeting will have a no-host 'meet and greet' cocktail hour at 5:00 p.m., with dinner and awards presentation to begin at 6:00 p.m. An alternative venue was also discussed and will be pursued, by Charlene Cooper, at the Idaho Center, which has a caterer on-site and a liquor license, for their large meeting room. Board members will be sent the info on Messenger in the near future, so a decision can be made on the awards meeting location. Board members can choose whether or not to approve the location and report back to LeAnne. Shawn is going to provide an outline for the awards dinner agenda.

The association also has 3 clinics scheduled for January, 2022, on the 8th, 15th, 22nd and the 29th at Mountain View Stables. Information regarding the awards dinner and the clinics will be added to the PNQHA website.

A brief discussion was held regarding the membership, which is currently \$25 per year. It was suggested that it be raised to \$30 per year. No decision was made on this issue.

A discussion regarding the PNQHA annual Trail ride was held, choosing June 11 or 25th, 2022, for next summer's event. Charlene will contact the appropriate individuals to finalize the date. The trail ride will be held on Eagle Island, and is a charity event.

Board members were reminded that PNQHA is planning on scheduling an AQHA Versatility Ranch Horse show on May 7 and 8, 2022, in the Treasure Valley area.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:40 p.m.
